



VESSEL REFUELLING RULES & REGULATIONS

It is a requirement here at St GMBC Marina that all clients are aware of and follow the appropriate procedures when fuelling a vessel. If you are unsure about any points in these procedures or you are not confident about fuelling here at St GMBC Marina, please ask for assistance at the office. We would be only too happy to assist:

- ✓ No Smoking, naked lights or flames.
- ✓ No motors running.
- ✓ Move away from bowsers to use mobile phone.
- ✓ Take portable tanks out of vessel for filling. Non approved fuel containers must not be filled (Use drip container supplied for filling portable tanks).
- ✓ Have rags as clean up equipment available.
- ✓ Know the location of tank vent and potential for fuel spillage.
- ✓ It is essential to stay with the nozzle whilst fuelling.
- ✓ Keep fuel nozzle in contact with the filler pipe, to prevent static electricity build up.
- ✓ Do not insert articles in nozzle trigger to hold open.
- ✓ Make sure fuel goes into the correct tank.
- ✓ Constantly monitor the tank contents & vents.
- ✓ Fill slowly towards the end.
- ✓ No Disembarking of passengers on fuel wharf.
- ✓ Clean up any spill immediately.
- ✓ Emergency Spill Kit & Fire Equipment clearly marked and located at fuel wharf and immediately inside the fuel wharf gate.
- ✓ Press break glass in an emergency for egress and access to fire fighting equipment
