



TRAILER PERMIT RULES

- Each Club Trailer Permit is for one vessel only and the Trailer Label Permit must be permanently fixed to the trailer. Each trailer permit is only allowed one boom gate token;
- The St George Motor Boat Club accepts no liability for any loss or damage to persons or property arising from the use of its boat ramp and trailer parking, operators use the boat ramp at their own risk;
- Persons with valid trailer labels should consider other members, by launching their vessels quickly and efficiently as possible while keeping to safe practices. This means prior to reversing onto the boat ramp members should prepare their vessel.
- The marina and its surrounding including the boat ramp, fuel berth and visitors berth are “**4 KNOT ZONES**” and “**NO WASH ZONES**”.
- Engines and vessels are **NOT** to be washed or flushed on the club premises at any time.
- Trailers are only to be parked in the designated trailer spots marked with white bollards. Should this space be full trailer parking should be found on the surrounding streets. **Trailers must be detached from vehicles whilst parked on club premises.**
- Cars and Vessels are not to be left parked or moored on the boat ramp or boat ramp pontoon unless they are being launched or retrieved.
- Trailers and vessels are **NOT** to be left in the Club Parking overnight. Penalties apply for those who do so.
- No business shall be operated from the STGMBC including its facilities without prior consent from marina management. This includes the boat ramp, visitors wharf and fuel berth.
